

Cyngor Cymuned Llangelynnin Community Council

Introduction

The Llangelynnin Community Council maintains, on a rechargeable basis, the Public Footpaths within the Community Council boundaries on behalf of Gwynedd Council.

This is an invitation to tender for the work as specified below on **Public Footpaths** –

Llwybr y Perthi – from the “Red Brick Bridge”, over the railway crossing to the foreshore.

Llwybr y Crynwyr – from the railway crossing down to the foreshore.

General

The contractor must have Public Liability Insurance and indemnify the Community Council against any claims.

The work to be carried out in a safe manner with due consideration to all footpath users at all times.

The footpath must remain open at all times unless arrangements are made to have the path officially closed.

Specification

Cutting back

To comprise cutting back tree branches and general undergrowth to provide a clear swathe of 1m each side of the edge of the footpath where possible, and 2.5m overhead – trees and ivy growth. Clearing adjacent to the railway kissing gates to be included in the item.

Clearing around benches

To comprise of cutting back general undergrowth to provide a clear swathe of 500mm surrounding the benches where possible - (x 6 benches).

Disposal

All arisings from the edging work, together with all branches and undergrowth to be disposed of at suitable locations adjacent to the footpath. Nothing to be disposed of in the river - Afon Gwrl.

3 grass cuts – to be done in May, July and September.

Copy of Liability Insurance Cover must be provided with estimate please.
